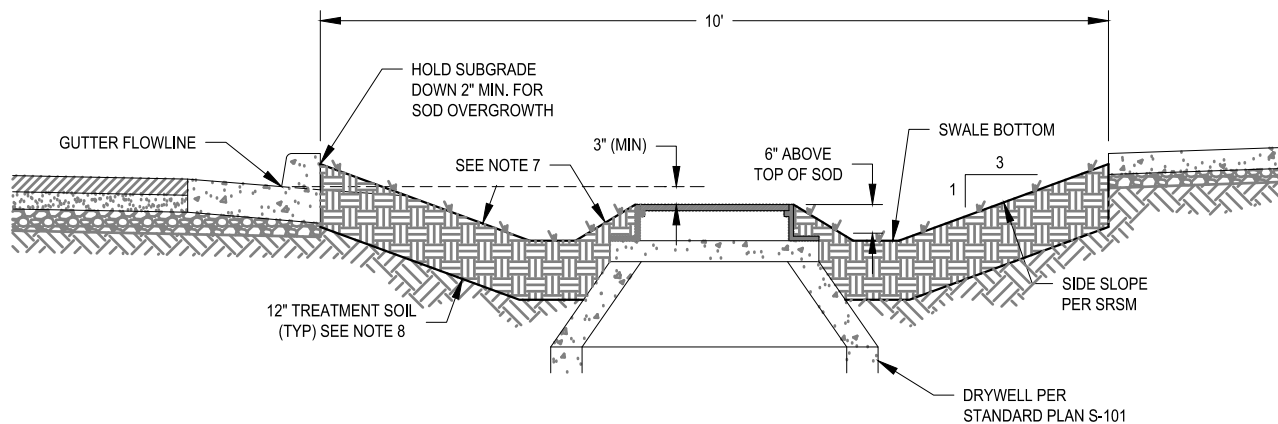


ISOMETRIC VIEW



SECTION A-A

GENERAL NOTES:

- SWALES WITH LONGITUDINAL SLOPE GREATER THAN 1% REQUIRE CHECK DAMS.
- DRYWELLS NOT TO BE WITHIN 5' - 9" OF INLET CENTERLINE.
- NO MORE THAN 4" OF TOPSOIL OVER UNCOMPACTED NATIVE SOIL.
- NO COMPACTION IN SWALE BOTTOM.
- SWALES ARE TO BE GRASSED AND IRRIGATED AS NECESSARY. SWALES WITHOUT IRRIGATION SHALL HAVE DROUGHT-TOLERANT DRYLAND GRASS.
- SWALES SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE SPOKANE REGIONAL STORMWATER MANUAL (SRSM).
- TOPSOIL SHALL BE SLOPED AROUND DRYWELL FRAME FROM BOTTOM OF SWALE TO TOP OF FRAME AT 3:1 MAXIMUM SLOPE.
- THE TOP 12" OF SOIL SHALL CONSIST OF A THOROUGHLY BLENDED MIX OF 50% COMPOST WITH 50% NATIVE SOIL.
