




A new type of traffic signal has appeared at some intersections in the City of Spokane Valley. Flashing yellow arrow traffic signals will improve traffic flow and increase driver convenience by decreasing left turn wait time.

To use flashing yellow arrow traffic signals, follow these easy directions:



STEADY RED — No left turns are allowed during red. Stop and wait for green arrow, or flashing yellow arrow.

STEADY YELLOW — Signal is about to turn red, prepare to stop, or complete turn if in the intersection.

FLASHING YELLOW — Left turns are permitted but not protected; proceed with caution after yielding to oncoming traffic.

STEADY GREEN — Left turns proceed and are protected from oncoming traffic.

Flashing yellow arrow signals have been installed at several Spokane Valley locations:

- Appleway/Farr
- Appleway/Barker
- Broadway/Evergreen
- Broadway/Walmart Entrance
- Pines/Mansfield
- Sprague/Conklin
